Chorus Registration and Information

The KGES Chorus members rehearse after school and are responsible for attending all rehearsals and 100% of performances. Meeting these requirements is your child's invitation to participate in our field trips!

As a chorus, we perform in **THREE** school concerts during the year: Winter Concert, In-School Winter Concert and Spring Concert. These three concerts are **mandatory**. Missing performances jeopardizes field trip participation.

How to obtain chorus information?

This packet has very important information to keep handy, such as **dismissal info, registration info,** and **concert info.** All of this information AND any future updates, schedules, and changes will be available online on the KGES-MUSIC website (kges-music.weebly.com) and on the chorus bulletin board in the music classroom.

How do you register your child for chorus?

Registration forms need to be turned in by <u>Friday</u>, <u>September 1st!</u> Choose a day (Monday or Tuesday) for your child to attend rehearsals, or choose the box that lets Ms. Forren assign your child a day to help keep both chorus groups even. Your child will attend the days that they sign up for AND the FULL chorus days. Full chorus means BOTH Monday and Tuesday groups meet to rehearse together. These full chorus days will be announced in advance.

All information in this packet MUST be completed to successfully register your child. Any child missing information from any form will NOT be allowed to attend rehearsals.

Once you turn in your registration, you will receive an email letting you know what day (Monday or Tuesday) your child needs to attend rehearsals. **Rehearsals end at 4:50pm SHARP!** Parents who are LATE picking their child up will be asked to sign up for an activity bus or to arrange another way of transportation home.

Registration Forms are due back to Ms. Forren by Friday, September 1st!

Chorus begins September 11th (Monday Members) and Sept 12th (Tuesday Members)

Chorus Dismissal Information

Parents,

You have three options for getting your child home from chorus.

- 1. Parent Pick Up
- 2. Activity Bus
- 3. Walking

Parent Pick Up:

Meet students in the cafeteria by **4:50pm**.

Show the Sign Out table your ID and wait for your student to enter the cafeteria from rehearsal. **PLEASE HAVE ID that matches the names listed on the dismissal form attached.**

PARENTS – if you KNOW you are going to be more than 15 minutes late PLEASE call one of the people on your dismissal form to pick your child up and send me a quick email! If you are over 15 minutes late TWO times—your child will not be permitted to stay for chorus unless an activity bus form is returned or other arrangements for pickup have been made

Please list the name of ANY person(s) that is allowed to pick up your child from chorus. This includes all parent/guardians, family members, family friends, etc. who may possibly pick your child up after rehearsals. If a name is not on the dismissal form and a note is not sent in prior to rehearsal letting us know the student will not be permitted to leave with that person.

Activity Bus:

Students will be escorted to their assigned bus.

No child will be put on an activity bus unless an activity bus form as been filled out and turned in to Ms. Forren. Your child does not have to use the activity bus every week, however, they must turn in a form to be able to **ever** use the bus. (**This is a good idea to fill out just in case there is a day you or the person picking your child up is unable to do so.**)

Walking

This is an option for any student who lives next door. No child will be allowed to walk unless Ms. Forren receives an email or parent note PRIOR to that day's rehearsal.

If you are giving your child permission to walk home every chorus rehearsal – please provide a note to Ms. Forren or attach it to the Dismissal Form stating you give your child permission to walk home after ALL chorus rehearsals.
